

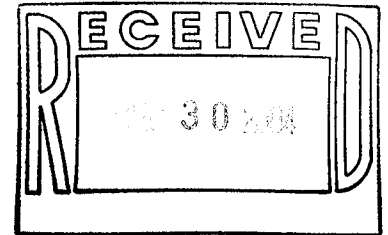

As required in the Programmatic Agreement for the Operation and Management of the Missouri River Main Stem System (PA), the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Omaha District (Corps) provided a preliminary draft Five-Year Plan on October 21, 2004.

The due date for comments on the subject document was December 17, 2004. At the recent PA semi-annual meeting held in Rapid City, South Dakota on December 14 to 16, the Advisory Council for Historic Preservation requested a 30-day extension to the comment period. With this letter, the Corps is extending the comment period until January 17, 2005.
