Dear Ms. Corbine:

The State of South Dakota Game, Fish, and Parks Department proposes to install a new rural water service line from the existing B-Y waterline to the new comfort station at the Chief White Crane Recreation Area (Enclosure 1). The property is located on the east side of Lake Yankton and northeast of the Training Dike area, approximately 1.5 miles from Gavins Point Dam, in Section 21, T93N, R56W in Yankton County (Enclosure 2).

A December 2004 file search revealed one site recorded in Section 21, but no sites within the recreation area itself (Blakeslee and O'Shea 1983). It was also noted that the area was heavily disturbed and remodeled by the previous dam construction.
