Dear Mr. Corbine:

The South Dakota Department of Game, Fish, and Parks, in cooperation with the Bon Homme-Yankton Electric Association, is proposing to install four new sections of buried electrical service lines in portions of the Lewis and Clark Recreation Area (enclosure 1). The work would consist of the placement of the lines at a depth of 48 inches using a cable plow and a directional bore. The lines will be primarily confined to existing road rights-of-way that have been previously disturbed. The project location is in Section 18, T93N, R56W and sections 13, 23, and 24, T93N, R57W, Yankton County, South Dakota (enclosure 2).

A December 2004 cultural resources file search revealed four recorded sites, which the Corps believes will not be impacted by the proposed work, within the recreation area:
